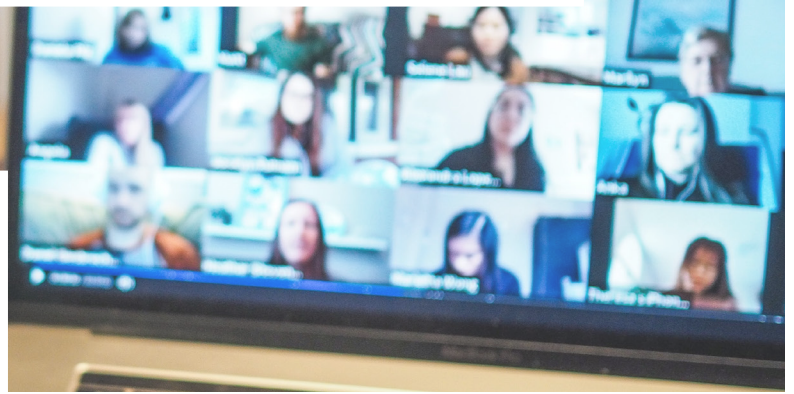
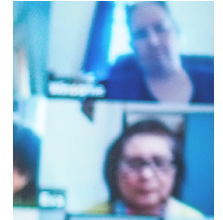


# The Disability Rights Wisconsin PAIMI Advisory Council Invites You to a Virtual Event:
