Medicare Savings Programs

State programs that can SAVE you money

You *may* qualify to get help paying for your Medicare premiums and other Medicare costs.

Wisconsin has programs that can help pay your Medicare expenses.

- Qualified Medicare Beneficiary (QMB)
- Specified Low-Income Medicare Beneficiary (SLMB)
- Specified Low-Income Medicare Beneficiary Plus (SLMB+)
- Qualified Disabled and Working Individual (QDWI)

If you qualify for **QMB**, **SLMB**, **SLMB+**, **or QDWI**, you automatically qualify for Extra Help.

Medicare has a special program called "Extra Help"

If you have limited income and resources, you can get help paying for the following costs in your Medicare Part D Drug plan:

- Part D monthly premium
- Part D annual deductible
- Part D prescription copayments

If you have <u>both</u> Medicaid and Medicare at the same time, you might already be eligible for Extra Help.

If you have Medicare, but <u>do NOT</u> have Medicaid, Wisconsin Medicaid has several programs or benefits for which you may be eligible.

"Extra Help" can provide significant savings.

Many people may qualify for these big savings and not even know it!
