Applying for Division of Vocational Rehabilitation Services

You can fill out an online referral application to ask the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation (DVR) to decide whether you're eligible for services:

If you can't apply online, call the main Division of Vocational Rehabilitation phone number (1-800-442-3477) and ask for contact information for your Workforce Development Area (WDA).

What about the Order of Selection?

As of December 2, 2025, the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation is using an **Order of Selection (OoS)**. It is a waitlist to decide when people get services. The Order of Selection will affect the timing between when you apply and when you will get services from the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation if they decide you're eligible.
